_____ **ANTH 605** - 4 credit hours, Conservation of Archaeological Resources I - Fundamentals and applications of artifact conservation techniques in archaeology

_____ **ANTH 606** - 4 credit hours, Conservation of Archaeological Resources II - Practical, hands-on experience on the identification and conservation of metal and organic artifacts. Prerequisite: ANTH 605

_____ **ANTH 617** - 3 credit hours, Conservation of Organic Materials - The goals of this course are to gain hands-on experience in the preservation of organic material culture using traditional and newly-discovered preservation methods. Students will conduct experimentation, developmental research, seminar classes, and applied artifact conservation.
